South Island Junior Baseball League Pilot Program for 2007

Greater Victoria Minor Baseball will be initiating the South Island Junior Baseball League in 2007. We will run the 1st season on a pilot basis to help us fully develop the program and work out any issues.

This league will be for players aged 18 to 21 as of December 31st with an emphasis on players who have graduated from recent midget programs (at all levels.) This will be an interlocking league among the five parks.(Layritz, Lambrick, Westshore, Peninsula and Carnarvon).

There will be three playing slots per week with the times being: Lambrick Park Saturday evening, Sidney Rotary during a weekday evening and West Shore Luxton during a weekday evening. League length will be about 18 games total, averaging 1.5 games per week with the season running from May to July, starting after college/university finishes.

Each team will have at least one adult manager to assume responsibility for the team with the parks supplying the equipment, uniform tops and hats. Each player must supply their own grey pants and batting helmets.

Players will be accepted on a first come first served basis and will register through their "home" parks. As this is our first year we are limiting the number of teams and may not be able to accommodate all players. If this program is successful, we will consider expansion in subsequent years.

This is a GVMBA league and is not associated with the Junior Men's league. (if you are interested in the Jr. Men's the contact is Duane Bertrand @727-0784)
